




It has been discovered through careful and secret research that a

BIO DOME SAVES STUDENT'S LIVES


west Nazarene University is to be reassured that the danger of dying students is still in the distance.

Cheese takes over the world

NEW YORK CITY – The crisis that developed after the Cheese Producing/Exporting Countries (CPEC) announced their intention to limit production of its product has continued to have drastic effects on the United States economy. CPEC has been the main producer of gourmet cheeses, including Swiss, Gouda, Limburger and Mozzarella, for more than a century. This most recent production cut is just one in a string of decreases dating back to the Cheese Crisis of the 70's.

Mark Fromage, a top Wall Street analyst, noted that this production limitation has raised the price of most cheeses from the last industry average of \$2.71 to \$2.83 per brick.

"This 12-cent price increase, while meaning a \$35 billion a year increase in sales for the cheese industry, also

means a huge negative affect on many other industries," Fromage stated.

The Pizza Hut Corporation has been forced to close down over one hundred restaurants in the US alone. Amanda Kissenug, spokeswoman for Pizza Hut, blamed CPEC for the mass closures.

"We can no longer afford to produce the *Cheese Lovers* pizza. We have also been forced to cut back on the cheese we put on other pizzas," explained Kissenug. "This means decreased sales for Pizza Hut and, needless to say, we are not pleased with the choices of CPEC."

Other restaurants have also been forced to shut down hundreds of chain stores, including McDonald's, Subway and Burger King. In one extreme case, the lives of the citizens in Green Bow, Minnesota, were thrown into uproar when all the res-

taurants in town closed their doors within three days of one another. National unemployment rates have skyrocketed as restaurants release hundreds of employees. Many spouses have been forced to quit their jobs in order to cook dinner.

The Wine Tasters Guild has had to cut down largely on its wine tasting parties, as the cheese used to cleanse the pallet is largely unavailable because of production cuts. This also affects the wine industry which is estimating its losses at 2 million bottles a year.

As people in the US line up at check-stands to get as much cheese as possible before the prices go up even more, the effect on the world economy and political structure has been far more devastating.

Famine has broken out in many third-world countries. The French have become even ruder, as they

can no longer afford to have cheese with their wine. Russia has had to quell several uprisings in Siberia and Irkutsk as the result of limiting cheese rations in those areas. China is attempting to invade Taiwan, although this crisis may be unrelated to cheese production.

Many Government officials are alarmed by the negative effect that this crisis is having. White House officials say that President Bush is seriously considering withdrawing from CPEC. However, Cheese Lobbyists from Wisconsin are putting considerable pressure on him and he is expected to rescind on the idea. The Cheese Lobby contributed \$3 billion to the Bush Presidential Campaign. Many Democrats are calling for an investigation into the possibility that these contributions were connected to sudden decreased production of cheese, as well as

President Bush's change in his stance on cheese in general.

Meanwhile, scientists have been working tirelessly to come up with alternatives to cheese in order to feed the world.

The Kraft Corporation has come forward with several new products that could replace cheese, but these replacements have not yet been refined to the point where they are cheaper to produce. Many people are attempting to replace cheese with things like cottage cheese or peanut butter, but most have found there to be something lacking in the taste and color.

CPEC's apparent disregard for the chaos it is causing, even in countries that are members, has outraged many people. It may only be a matter of time before there is an uprising against the tyranny of CPEC.

CIA secret weather experiments rage out of control

While many Americans simply presume that the weather is an act of nature out of their control, this assumption now appears to be quite naïve. Sources close to *The Inquisitor* have recently revealed that some of the deadliest, most dangerous weather patterns in the United States have in fact been set into motion by the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA).

The CIA organization have been performing weather experiments with the Microwave Cannon Weather-Improvement Device (MCWID). Completed in October of 2000, it was created as a result of information obtained from Russian scientists. Many Russian technologies were made easily obtainable at that time.

tained special permission from the White House to begin testing the new cannon and at first the results looked quite promising. The CIA is currently working on fixing the problem by using the cannon again but are not being allowed to do so by the White House. Hopefully, both the CIA and White House will get things in order with the nation's weather soon. The CIA wishes to improve conditions, wanting Americans to feel free to go outside and actually enjoy the weather instead of fearing for their very lives.

President Bush announces plan to resign by August

WASHINGTON, D.C.— Newly elected President George W. Bush has assumed office after the most grueling, knockdown, drag out election in living memory. Yet incredibly, he plans to quit by August, inside sources say.

White House insiders claim the aim of what they call the Bush “early exit strategy” is to use the honeymoon period every new President gets with Congress to push through his own personal political agenda. Democrats who have gotten wind of the early resignation plan are furious.

“They were hoping that Bush would be stuck with a political hot potato, a sour economy, and his perceived failure would cripple the Republican party,” said Niegold. “George W. has figured out a way to outsmart them. In a way, it’s masterful.”

But Democrats insist they are not a bit impressed by the supposed brilliance of the Bush plan.

“What’s been coming out of the White House is a Republican spin on a looming political fiasco,” said a leading Democratic Party strategist, who requested anonymity.

HOT PANTS INVOLVED IN TRIPLE MURDER/SUICIDE

A missing woman was found late Monday, April 2, stuffed inside a pair of leather pants. Boise-area police had been looking for the victim, Amanda Huginkis, for about three months after the 22-year-old was reported missing.

Sources close to *The Inquisitor* reported that when the body was found, many local officers could not bear to look at the young lady being yanked from the dried dead cow skin. When Huginkis was eventually extracted, police found a business card in the pocket of the pants. The exact inscription on the card has led to some confusion. Some have said it read: “Yeah, your mother!” while privately authorities have told *The Inquisitor* that it actually said, “Joey’s Rear Huggers.” This connection to the popular brand of jeans has led to scrutiny of the designer.

The main suspect in the case has been identified as cult leader Bishop “Gimpy Leg” Joey, founder of Joey’s Rear Huggers and also a well-known religious cult, *The Cow Skins of the New Millennium*. The actual name of Joey is unknown, but he is an investor in Verizon Wireless systems. Early Tuesday, Boise officers stormed the compound of *The Cow Skins of the New Millennium*. Team

leader, Jackson Hewitt told our reporters, “It didn’t take much force. The metal on the trailer was very easy to cut through.”

As police got closer, hoping to find the leader, all they found was 67,000 pairs of leather hot pants. Neither of the cult members were found in the compound. Police conducted a full search of the Happy Hills Trailer Park, the reported headquarters of the cult, but the search turned up nothing.

Later Tuesday, another pair of leather hot pants was discovered under the nearby Ninth Street Bridge. Inside were both of the other cult members.

That evening, on a lucky break, the police received a call from the Boise Airport. The subject of that call was unknown, but within 45 minutes, the police had swarmed the airport and were in a standoff with Bishop Joey. He began hurling leather hot pants at them from afar and, after seriously wounding six officers, he finally decided to make a run for it.

The police responded by detonating a small section of the terminal with C-4 plastic explosive. After the numerous explosions subsided, Bishop Joey was found dead, in his hand was a mask and the police saw who he really was underneath it. Sources close to *The Inquisitor* have reported that it was legendary singer Mel Torme from the old abandoned circus.



friends. Pike and Marble are complete opposites in personality, which makes the set up even tougher.

From there, the story escalates into a hilarious escapade as Marble finally rejects Pike and falls in love with freshman Brent Earwicker (Leonard Nimoy).

Other students claimed seeing the same creature, but some did not see the demonic presence on its hind quarters.


The religion and philosophy department staff were buzzing
